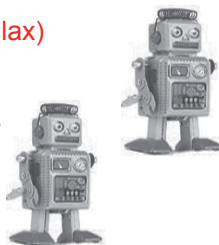


June 14-18 Robotics II (Parallax)

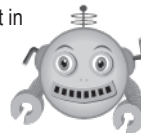
